

BaptistWay Press® Scope and Sequence for Early Childhood, Children and Youth

1. The scope of BaptistWay Press® Bible study curriculum materials encompasses the entire biblical revelation, with significant adjustments for age appropriateness for early childhood, children and youth.
2. Since BaptistWay Press curriculum materials are undated, a church has the option of constructing its own scope and sequence according to its own needs. That is, the church may construct its own curriculum plan from all the BaptistWay Press materials available.

Several factors guide this sequence, as follows:

- (a) Units that appear at the beginning of the year take special account of the likely level of development of this particular age group as the year begins.
 - (b) Units take account of the major seasons of the Christian year—Christmas and Easter. For early childhood, additional special days and seasons are interwoven into the various units, such as Thanksgiving, Mother’s Day, and Father’s Day.
 - (c) For early childhood, the sequence of units balances the major concept areas. For children, the scope and sequence of units balances the various subject areas.
