

Multihousing Missionaries and Pastor Mentors

(or pastor-designated trainers)

Note: Teach only as much as your “mentees” will need to get started. Use this website as a “cafeteria” of resources to select the essentials needed in your setting.

- A. **Any growing Christian** can become a local “Multihousing Missionary” from their church to a multihousing community by:
- (1) being mentored by the pastor or designated church leader through a free training guide, and
 - (2) being affirmed by the church in a simple **“Prayer Commissioning”** at the end of any regular church gathering (certificate provided).
 - (3) most remain active in their home church and
 - (4) count the **attendance/baptisms** at the multihousing congregation as a part of the sponsor church’s extended ministry.
- B. **Pastors can mentor** local church multihousing missionaries, passing on what God has built into their own lives. One pastor teaches similar missionaries for only **6 weeks** before sending them out to begin “satellite” congregations...40 have been planted in two years! This has become his most fruitful investment as a pastor.
- C. **Multihousing Congregations can be started** with little or not funds that reach persons who have mentally distanced themselves from a church building. New people are **baptized and discipled**, long-time Christians become missional, and pastors multiply their life-ministry!



Honorariums, free training guides, and prayer-commissioning certificates are available to participating pastors, multihousing pastors, or pastor-designated trainers in a local church.
