


## Mali

Mali is the eighth largest country on the continent of Africa. The northern part of Mali reaches into the Sahara Desert. Mali is one of the hottest places in the world, and the people there often experience droughts (no rain) and famine (no crops for food). Pray for the Senufo-Supyire (sen OO foh soo PEER ay) people to hear and believe the good news about Jesus as missionaries like Monica and Krystal tell them stories from the Bible.



## West Africa

Eighteen countries make up the large region known as West Africa, including Burkina Faso, Ivory Coast, Mali, Niger, and Senegal. The Atlantic Ocean is to the west and south of this region, and the Sahara Desert is to the north. Most West Africans are Muslim, though there are a few Christians. Pray for missionaries like Kimberly Cain to use her storying cloth to tell children in West Africa the good news about Jesus.




## Burkina Faso

Burkina Faso is a country in West Africa. People in Burkina Faso speak French, but many people also speak traditional languages of their people groups. Many people are Muslim, and many of the Christians who live there mix other traditions with their belief in Jesus. Pray for Christian workers who use storying to tell truckers the good news about Jesus. Pray that God will keep Christian truckers safe on the road as they bring the good news of Jesus to others.



## Ivory Coast

Ivory Coast, also known as Cote d'Ivoire (coat DEE vwahr), is a West African country along the Atlantic Ocean. The official language of Ivory Coast is French, though there are 78 languages spoken there. It is the world's largest producer of cocoa beans. Muslims live in the north and Christians live in the south, and there are many people who practice traditional beliefs. Pray for missionaries like the McAfees to tell people the good news about Jesus.



## Senegal

Senegal is a West African country on the coast of the Atlantic Ocean. The name *Senegal* comes from the Wolof language, and it means “our canoe.” Many people in Senegal say, “We are all in the same canoe.” Nearly all of the people living in Senegal are Muslim with only a small amount of people who are Christian. Pray for Christians and missionaries in Senegal to boldly tell others the good news about Jesus through Bible storying.



## Niger

Most of Niger (NEE jair or NIGH jair) is in the Sahara Desert. Because of the desert and hot climate, many people in Niger struggle to grow crops and find safe drinking water. Many children and adults have not had a chance to go to school because it takes so much work to grow food. Pray for the Songhai people of Niger and the missionaries who tell the Songhai about Jesus’ love for them.



## Indianapolis, Indiana

Indianapolis is the capital and largest city in Indiana in the United States. Indianapolis is called “the Crossroads of America” because of all the highways and railroads that intersect there. Even though Indianapolis is a large city, not many people in Indianapolis follow Jesus. Pray for missionaries like the Ragers to show people in the inner city how much Jesus loves them. Pray that people in Indianapolis will hear and believe the good news about Jesus.
