

CODE OF CONDUCT

All club members including Board Members, coaches, players, and parents are expected to abide by the club's Code of Conduct stated below during all club related functions. Club related functions include games, practices, tournaments, travel, club events, and club related activities.

9.01 Conduct of Board Members

Board Members must exemplify the highest level of standards and professionalism. All Board Members are to be a positive influence to all club members and to the community. The Board reserves the right to remove another Board Member for violation of rules or misconduct.

9.02 Conduct of Coaches

Coaches must represent the club in accordance with the USA Volleyball Code of Ethics. Coaches are to provide players with opportunities to improve their skills and display their abilities in competition. Coaches are responsible for displaying an encouraging and motivating attitude towards players, and maintaining positive relationships with parents and members. The Board reserves the right to remove a coach for violation of rules or misconduct.

9.03 Conduct of Players

Players are expected to participate in club activities. Being that the selection of the player denies another potential player the opportunity to participate, players must be willing to commit their time to attend practices, tournaments, and club functions. Players must conduct themselves in a positive manner as a representation of Kūle'a Volleyball Club and what the club stands for. Players are required to demonstrate sportsmanship to opponents and other participants at all times. The Board reserves the right to remove a player for violation of rules or misconduct.

9.04 Conduct of Parents

Parent participation is strongly encouraged with Kūle'a Volleyball Club. Parents of players are expected to conduct themselves in a positive and supportive manner at all practices, games, and club functions. Parents are invited to meet with coaches and Board Members if there is a need to express concerns, and must do so in a respectful and considerate manner. The Board reserves the right to ban a parent from club activities for violation of rules or misconduct.
