CONCORD BOCCE FEDERATION COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS

The Concord Bocce Federation (CBF) has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, CBF **CANNOT GUARANTEE** that you or your teammates will not become infected with COVID-19. By signing the COVID-19 Waiver form, you acknowledge you have read these requirements and agree to abide by them.

- 1. All players must sign a CBF COVID-19 Waiver form
 - a. Capos must confirm all waivers have been signed and returned prior to start of season.
 - b. Each capo is responsible for ensuring these safety protocols are followed by each player.
- 2. If you are sick, STAY HOME.
- 3. If you have any signs of COVID infection (cough, sneezing, nausea, etc.), STAY HOME.
- 4. Masks **MUST** be worn at all times; this includes persons who have been vaccinated.
- 5. Keep 6' distance from others. Consider bringing your personal chair and place it 6' away from others and permanent benches and tables.
- 6. It is recommended that bocce participants bring and use **self-provided** hand sanitizer.
- 7. No spectators will be allowed at the courts. Only players on the roster of the night playing will be allowed to be inside the bocce ball gates.
- 8. There will be **NO food and drink sharing**. You may bring individual portions only.
 - a. If a player needs to eat or drink, they must stay 6' away from all persons, remove mask, eat/drink, and then reapply mask and apply hand sanitizer.
- 9. Players must leave the premises once their games have finished. No loitering.
- 10. Spray bottle cleanser and paper towels will be stocked in the equipment shed. Clean the balls before you begin to play and at the conclusion of play.
- 11. There will be containers of hand sanitizer in the building. When you pick up your balls, please take a container of sanitizer for a table. Please make sure there is one container on each table.
- 12. COVID-19 testing and positive test protocol:
 - a. Player(s) must quarantine from league play for at least 10 days, starting on the day of positive test results.
 - b. Players in close contact should take actions they feel necessary at their own expense.
 - c. Testing will be at the players expense and will not be reimbursed by CBF for any costs associated with possible contraction of COVID-19.
- 13. As/if things ease up, you will be notified of changes. **DO NOT TAKE IT UPON YOURSELF TO ASSUME THE ABOVE ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED**. You will be notified by a Board Member, by email or on the website.

CBF Board Members reserve the right to ask any player who is not adhering to any of these guidelines to leave the premises
