- 4. Be respectful to all players, coaches, game officials, parents, and spectators. Always act in a professional manner.
- 5. Require your players and parents to follow FD Academy Players/Parents Sportsmanship Code of Conduct. Encourage your team's spectators/parents to behave during matches and supportive of all players.
- 6. Try to make each and every experience a positive one. I understand that winning is the goal, BUT not everything. We do not win at the cost of our integrity.
- 7. Never use profane or vulgar language in the presence of players or parents. Use appropriate language and behavior while coaching. Be a role model of appropriate behavior.

- 9. Never use alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs around your players at practices and games.
- 10. Prepare players to learn, improve and compete to the best of their ability. Also provide timely and honest assessments of players' ability and potential.
