1. Called to Order 6:10 – Dave Shoemaker
2. Discussed possible field upgrades and field relocation by CARD. Dave Donnan (CARD Board Member) discussed what was being discussed by CARD relating to upgrading field to Turf. Because of the uniqueness of Sycamore Field, it does not appear Sycamore will be in the consideration to be upgraded, however there may be new fields created at 20th Street Park that CSSC could consider moving to. In addition, other current field may have openings in use that CSSC may want to consider using in the future because of lights and Turf surfaces.
3. Discussed Ron Hunt Hall of Fame games and Year-End BBQ – August 20th. Ben Teitz agreed to take care of all the BBQ at a cost of \$200 plus food/drink costs. As voted upon earlier in the year, teams in draft opposition will pick the other team's participants on: Vets July 19th, Open July 22nd and Masters' July 22nd & 27th.
4. Discussed year-end awards. Board decided that because of the extended season and the need to carry over funds there will be no team awards for season champions and tournament champions. Dave will develop some type of certificate to give to the teams. There will be Sportsman of the Year awards in all three divisions and there will be Hall of Fame inductees. Sportsman nominations along with new Board Member nominations will be made during the week of July 12th and voting for same will happen during the week of July 19th.

5. Discussed what softball the league wants to use next year. The Board decided to insure there was enough money carried over to allow for purchase of next season's softball sometime in Oct or Nov. New Board will need to determine which softballs to use based upon cost and availability.
6. Discussed projects around Sycamore Field to be submitted to CARD. Board did not have any new projects to submit but will continue to push for outfield improvements along with different field upkeep practices and for a permanent bathroom for players and spectators use.
7. Old Business – Ron Adams reported that the Masters Division as a whole voted to change the throw out at 1st base rule back to no throw out from outfield.
