1. Called to Order 9:00 A.M. 5/4/2020

2. Discuss Status of 2020 Season Start

Discussed opening regular season on June 1<sup>st</sup>, Board voted 7/0 to set a June 1<sup>st</sup> start date. Update - Sent off a message to Butte County Health Officer to see if that will be possible and gave them our new rules for social distancing, but we have also received word from CARD that our new Year-End Tournament dates would have conflict with things going on at Hooker Oak and Rex Murphy fields, so we may have to move to 20th Street. Also asked the Butte County Health Officer if we could possibly start playing May 26th because that would then move our Year-End by 1 week into a good window at Hooker Oak & Rex Murphy.

3. Discussed implantation of Social Distancing Rules, Board voted 7/0 to implement. New rules to be posted on Website (if approved by County) and emailed to all Coaches and registered players.

4. Discussed Scheduling Options. Board voted to play the same number of games as originally scheduled, but to play twice a week to enable completion of the regular league prior to Labor Day Holiday. The Masters will move to playing in the morning on Tuesday/Thursday. The Open will play on Tuesday/Thursday in the afternoon. The Veterans will play on Monday/Wednesday in the afternoon to help the Masters' maintain the most players they can.

5. Discussed the All-Star game and Year End Tournament. Both events may have to have dates adjusted based up actual start date of normal season. The Board voted to discuss and finalize at their June meeting.

6. Discuss purchase of Thermal Temperature Thermometer (Non-Contact Gun)  
We did not have a clear decision on whether it was advantageous to buy and use a Thermal Temperature gun, so this issue will be placed on the June agenda for further discussion/decision

7. Discussed Hats for All-star participants, however the Board could not come to a final decision and wanted more time to discuss pro and cons, so this item will be reconsidered at the June Board meeting.
