Where: Plymouth High School Varsity Baseball Field. Use the tennis court parking lot off of Joy Rd, west of Salem High School. The baseball field is behind the tennis courts.

Cost: \$45 Includes a snack, drink, and T-Shirt. Additional Plymouth Wildcat spirit wear will be available for purchase. Check-In: 8:30am for the early session and 12:30pm for the afternoon session at the Baseball concession stand
