Coaching Staff Code Of Conduct

HHS

In order to participate in any Huber Heights Soccer Association function, this form must be read by all coaching staff members to include assistant coaches and team mom. The coaching staff agrees to abide by the guidelines set forth in this document, and to conduct themselves in a manner conductive to good sportsmanship and fair play. Failure to abide by this Code of Conduct, or violation of any of the guidelines set forth, will be subject to the consequences as listed below. Any HHS Board Member or Referee has the right to enforce these rules and regulations; however, violations may be appealed to the HHS board in writing within 72 hours of the incident. Yellow or Red card violations may not be appealed.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP

- 1. I will place the emotional and physical well being of my players ahead of a personal desire to win. I will be gracious in victory and accept defeat with dignity.
- 2. I will treat each player as an individual, remembering the large range of emotional and physical development within the same age group.
- 3. I will always inspect practice and game venues to insure safe playing conditions. I will require players to be properly equipped at all times.
- I will promise to review and practice the basic first aid principles needed to treat injuries of my players.
- 5. I will organize practices that are both fun and challenging for all my players.
- 6. I will be a positive role model for my players, leading by example by always demonstrating sportsmanship and empathizing fair play.
- 7. I will use those coaching techniques appropriate for each of the skills that I teach.
- 8. I will remember that I am a youth sports coach, and that the game is for children and not adults.
- 9. I will become knowledgeable in the rules of soccer, teach them to the players, and support all league policies and regulations as set forth by the Huber Heights Soccer Association.
- 10. I will respect the judgment of game officials, abide by the rules of soccer, and display no behavior that could incite fans.
- 11. I will refrain from abusive verbal or physical confrontation with another parent, coach, official, or participant. I will refrain from vulgar, lewd, or obscene language or gestures while participating in, or watching any Huber Heights Soccer event.

Physical abuse violations will not be tolerated and will result in the immediate and permanent dismissal from <u>ALL</u> HHS programs.

1st Violation

Other than physical abuse, will result in an immediate suspension from the current and one subsequent HHS function. **2nd Violation** Will result in the immediate dismissal from ALL HHS programs for 12 consecutive months. Infractions are cumulative and life long.
