

Parent Code Of Conduct

- 1. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all participants, Coaches, Officials, Board Members, and Staff in HHS sponsored events.
- 2. I will be accountable for any other children in my control that attend, but are not participating in practice sessions or games.
- 3. I will support all coaches, board members and others working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- 4. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for the youth and not adults.
- 5. During the course of a game, I will refrain from confronting any official, coach, board member, or staff for any reason, unless there is considered to be an emergency regarding the physical well being of a participant. In this event, the conversation must be done in a formal and quiet fashion.
- 6. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
- 7. I will instruct my child to treat other participants, coaches, board members, parents and spectators, with respect, regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
- 8. I will, along with any guest of mine, refrain from abusive verbal or physical confrontation with another parent, coach, official, or participant. I will refrain from vulgar, lewd, or obscene language or gestures while participating in, or watching any HHS event.
- 9. I will direct all my comments and criticisms to parents, participants, officials, board members away from the children participating in the association, and conduct myself in a calm civilized manner when doing so.

<u>1st Violation</u> Other than physical abuse, will result in an immediate suspension from the current and one subsequent HHS function. <u>2nd Violation</u> Will result in the immediate dismissal from ALL HHS programs for 12 consecutive months. Infractions are cumulative and life long.

Player Code Of Conduct

- 1. No jewelry (bracelets, necklaces, rings, earrings, watches, etc.). This includes newly pierced ears with studs, posts, or wires. Also, includes any body piercing eg. Bellybutton, lip, tongue, etc. No Jewelry means No Jewelry. No Exceptions!
- 2. No eating candy, food or chewing gum while playing or practicing.
- 3. Hair should be pulled back with a plain ponytail holder. No hair clips or hard plastic pony tail holders.
- 4. Player game uniform is a team jersey, socks, and approved shorts, as furnished by HHS, approved soccer cleats and shin guards (to be worn under socks not exposed).
- 5. Practice uniform is appropriate jersey, (provocative clothing will not be tolerated), shorts (no jean shorts), shin guards, no apparel will have exposed buttons, zippers, cords, hoods, pockets or any other object that might become entangle with another player. This applies to practice and games.
- 6. Players may wear shorts over sweats for cool weather, games or practice.
- 7. Players are to treat other players and opponents with respect. Shake hands after games. Do not embarrass, demean, taunt, or intimidate other players or opponents with ridiculing motions, finger gestures, or trash talking. Absolutely no cursing.
- 8. Respect the judgment of game officials, abide by the rules of practices and games, and display no behavior that could incite fans.
- 9. Cooperate with officials, coaches, and fellow players to conduct a fair game.
- 10. Accept seriously the responsibility and privilege of representing the association and your sponsor, display positive public actions at all times.
- 11. Live up to the high standard of sportsmanship established by your coaches and the Huber Heights Soccer Association.

Failure to abide by these rules as set forth could result in disciplinary action, which could result in suspension or expulsion from HHS functions and loss of league fees.
