## WJ COPPER HILLS BASEBALL 2018 Release Agreement

As a participant in WJ Copper Hills Cal Ripken Baseball League (parent, player, coach, spectator, etc.), I will participate according to the rules and regulations set forth by the league. This includes while visiting other parks. I will adhere to the code of conduct at each park to make this an enjoyable and exciting experience for all involved in these programs.

As a parent, I will hold myself and player to a high standard and will put the enjoyment of the players of the league as my first priority. If I become loud, belligerent, rude or inappropriate to any player, coach, parent, league official, and especially our youth umpires, I will be asked to leave the park and will comply with said request.

## Fans/Spectators

Any spectator ejected from a game must immediately leave the Ron Wood Complex. Any spectator refusing to leave the complex in a timely matter, it will be considered a 2nd ejection immediately.

- 1. 1st ejection. Fan/Spectator is removed from Ron Wood Baseball Complex until the team they are watching plays an additional full game.
- 2. 2nd ejection in a season. Suspension to be determined from 3 games up to removal for the remaining Baseball season.

## Plaver

Any player that is ejected from any baseball game, will be required to have a meeting with the League President, VP over Commissioner, Division Commissioner the player is playing in, Head Coach and player parents. This is to determine the length of the suspension if required.

I will use the Babe Ruth Sportsman code as a guide for my player and myself to help ensure the best experience possible.

## The Sportsman Code of Babe Ruth

Develop a strong, clean, healthy body, mind and soul.

Develop a strong urge for sportsmanlike conduct.

Develop understanding of and respect for the RULES.

Develop courage in defeat, tolerance and modesty in victory.

Develop control over emotions and speech.

Develop spirit of cooperation and team play.

Develop into real, true CITIZENS

I will not use tobacco or alcohol around any of the youth participants in the league, including at games and practices. All West Jordan City Parks strictly prohibits both, including Ron Wood Baseball Complex.

As posted by the city, there are NO DOGS allowed at Ron Wood Baseball Park. I will be respectful of the rules and the safety of people and leave my dogs at home.

Posted city signs also indicate NO bicycles, scooters, skateboards, roller blades and sunflower seeds at Ron Wood Baseball Park. I will be respectful of the rules and the safety of people and not bring these items into the park.

I understand that each team and team fans are responsible for cleaning their respective dugout and bleacher area after every game.

In the event of an injury, I hereby authorize the coaches of the respective teams and/or league officials to initiate treatment and to seek appropriate medical attention. Pursuant to the passage of House Bill 204, Protection of Athletes with Head Injuries and in order to help protect participants in youth sporting events, effective January 1, 2012 WJ Copper Hills Baseball requires that athletes, parents/guardians and coaches follow the WJCH Head Injury Policy and Procedures. I understand that if I choose to play my child up a division, they will not be eligible to play back down in their respective age group for all-stars.

I have read, understand, accept and agree to all of the above items for the benefit of all players in this league.
