SCOTUS Upholds Federal Subsidies

This morning the Supreme Court of the United States (SCOTUS) announced that the decision of the Fourth Circuit is affirmed in *King v. Burwell* with a vote of 6-3. Chief Justice Roberts delivered the opinion of the Court, and those in majority are the Chief Justice and Justices Kennedy, Ginsburg, Breyer, Sotomayor, and Kagan. Justice Scalia wrote the dissent.

What does it mean? In short, the Court found in favor of the administration and upheld subsidies in the federal exchange.
