(Song of Solomon 1:2-3) Let him kiss me with the kisses of his mouth for your love is more delightful than wine. Pleasing is the fragrance of your perfumes; <u>your name is like perfume</u> poured out. No wonder the young women love you.

(Song of Solomon 1:5-6) I am dark but beautiful, O women of Jerusalem— dark as the tents of Kedar, dark as the curtains of Solomon's tents. <u>Don't stare at me</u> because I am dark— the sun has darkened my skin. My brothers were angry with me; they forced me to care for their vineyards, so I couldn't care for myself—my own vineyard.
