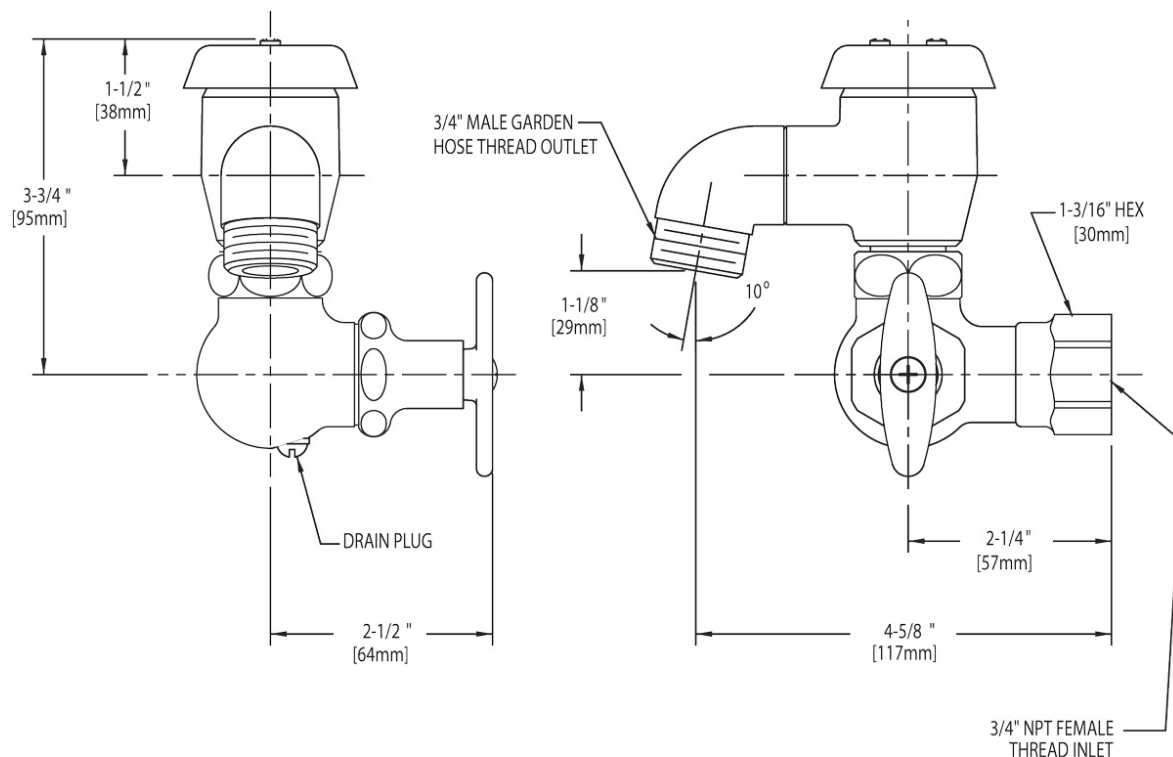

Architect/Engineer Specification

Chicago Faucets No. 998-RCF, Inside Sill Fitting with body drain plug and vacuum breaker, wall-mounted, rough chrome plated. 2-1/4" metal tee handle with square, tapered broach. Slow compression rebuildable cartridge, opens and closes 360° for fine adjustment, closes with water pressure, features square, tapered stem. 3/4" NPT female thread inlet. NOTE: Atmospheric vacuum breaker is NOT intended for continuous pressure applications.



Operation and Maintenance

Installation should be in accordance with local plumbing codes. Flush all pipes thoroughly before installation. After installation, remove spout outlet or flow control and flush faucet thoroughly to clear any debris. Care should be taken when cleaning the product. Do not use abrasive cleaners, chemicals or solvents as they can result in surface damage. Use mild soap and warm water for cleaning and protecting the life of Chicago Faucet products.
