THIS ROLE

As a 1099 Counselor at Ridge Counseling Services, you will minister through clinical and biblical counseling techniques to individuals, who are seeking help for a variety of issues, including depression, anxiety, relational issues, trauma, spiritual issues and concerns, grief and more. You will be responsible for delivering counseling services consistent with the RCS, vision, beliefs, and evidence-based clinical interventions to empower our clients to find emotional and spiritual healing.

JOB DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Typically provide between six to eight one-hour sessions per client.
- Once the initial intake is complete, contact the client within 48 hours to schedule.
- Rely on experience and judgment to create a plan and goals, focusing on root causes from a holistic perspective with a biblical understanding of the human person.
- Help clients move toward emotional, spiritual, and physical health.
- When appropriate, incorporate Christian disciplines (such as prayer, forgiveness, and Scripture reading) into the process.
- Work collaboratively with other members of the client's treatment team (psychiatrist, medical doctor, family members, significant others, or pastors as identified by the client).
- Protect the client's confidential information.
- Complete the required documentation to monitor the identified client's progress and ensure that all documentation is in the client's file within the time frame established by RCS.
- Prepare for, attend, and participate in individual sessions.

- Possess a vibrant and growing faith in Jesus Christ.
- Be an encourager and have a positive attitude.
- Maintain active membership and participation at a local church.
