

RECOMMENDED TOOLS & RESOURSES FOR PAVE SETTING



The pave setting student pack includes 6 x setting blanks, 120 x 2mm round CZ's & 40 x 1.5mm CZ's



Ensure you have; Drills 0.9mm & 1.2mm. Round burs 1.2mm 1.5mm & 1.7mm. Tapered (fissure) bur 1mm. Hart bur 1.3mm & 1.8mm or tapered setting bur 1.5mm & 2mm



You will need a good quality measuring devise as you need to check bur size. A leverage (stone) gauge is my choice. A steel rule is also used.



I use a scalpel for marking out, but you can use a scribe. I also recommend that you have a pair of precision dividers.



A ring clamp or bench-mate. I like to perform most of my work free hand, but you may need to clamp your work during some procedures.



I generally use a micro motor for drilling & burring, but a standard pendant motor can be just as good if set up correctly.



You will need a beading set to perform final claw tip shaping.



2.5mm square graver a #12 flat graver & an onglette graver. Jewellers must also be able to make tools for certain tasks. There are videos on how to make your own setting tools so make sure you have some spare graver handles.



I recommend that you have a brownie and greenie clean up disk for polishing the cut work. For cutting and shaping steel for tool making you will need a separating disk & shaft or a diamond disk
