

RECOMMENDED TOOLS & RESOURSES FOR BEZEL SETTING



The bezel setting student pack includes; 5 x setting blanks, 6 x 6mm round CZ's & 6 x 6mm square CZ's



The recommended burs for this course are; Hart bur 1.5mm & 2mm & 3mm - 4mm. Round bur 0.5 mm 1.5mm & 1.8mm.



Your dividers should be good quality fine pointed precision dividers.



Marking tools. A scribe & scalpel are handy marking tools for setting. I also recommend that you have a fine nibbed permanent marker.



Ensure you have good quality measuring devises. A leverage (stone) gauge is my choice.



Stone tweezers and a jewellers loupe should always be close at hand. I also use an Optivisor with a 5x magnification lens.



I generally use a micro motor for drilling & burring, but a standard pendant motor can be just as good if set up correctly.



For bezel setting hammer tools will make the task easier. A hammer handpiece that fits to your pendant motor works well, but a Dremel tool is better.



The course includes videos on how to make setting tools and prepare a graver. You will need three handles a nail a short piece of brass or copper wire & and a #12 flat
