


RECOMMENDED TOOLS & RESOURSES FOR STAR & BRIGHT CUTTING



The star & bright cutting student pack includes; 5 x SB10 setting blanks, 130 x 2mm 2.5mm & 3mm round CZ's



Ensure you have; Drills 0.7mm & 1.2mm. Setting burs 2.5mm & 3mm. Bud or cone bur 3mm. Hart bur 2.4mm



During the lesson I show you how to make a template for marking four even points out. You can use a standard template for this too.



I use a scalpel for most marking out but you can use a scribe. I also recommend that you have a pair of precision dividers at hand.



You will need to keep your gravers sharp and polished. I use an Eze lap diamond plate to sharpen my graver. You can make a large sanding stick with 2000 grit paper and a piece of leather to keep your gravers polished



The gravers I recommend for this course are Square (2.5mm) and a Flat (1.5mm)

You will need to buy handles too.



A ring clamp or bench-mate. I like to perform most of my work free hand, but you may need to clamp your work during some procedures.



You will need a beading set to perform final claw tip shaping. A video is included showing how to other setting tools.



I generally use a micro motor for drilling & burring, but a standard pendant motor can be just as good if set up correctly.
