

INATBA is 'the' interlocutor for Governments providing a truly independent platform to engage in outcome based public private discussions on DLT and blockchain technologies.




INATBA Objectives

Collaborate

Communicate

To act as a voice for governments, regulators, international organisations and standard setting bodies.

Advise

To advise the association on issues of public policy, particularly whereby a convergence of regulatory approaches is desirable and/or existing legal frameworks affect the deployment Blockchain and DLT solutions.



Academic Advisory Body - Purpose

Collaborate

To further INATBA's objectives by facilitating close collaboration with and within the academia and the research community by collaboration with INATBA Working Groups and with the Board of Directors.

Communicate

A representative set of distinguished scientists and senior researchers from various disciplines to act as a voice for academia and the research community.

Advise

To provide advice to the Association on academic issues, in particular, in matters where there is interaction between the Association's activities and advancements in scientific research.



Standards are critical to growth

Leading INATBA's efforts related to co-ordination and harmonization of Standards, to encourage global standardization efforts in Blockchain and DLT

The INATBA Standards Committee is leading these efforts in particular through:

- promoting and facilitating sustainable growth, prosperity and security in the various efforts to deploy trusted global blockchain service infrastructures across the world.
- interacting and collaborating with policy makers, regulators and governments
- interacting with INABTA's members, and with relevant standards bodies

Standards Committee

Strives to be a driving force to encourage global standardization efforts in Blockchain and DLT. It aims to work with emphasis on three dimensions:

- Pull and Push on the INATBA Working Groups.
 - For example:
 - Identifying commonalities across the subjects of the respective WGs (e.g. SSI, Privacy & UOI)
 - · Identifying patterns and issuing papers for policy makers and regulators (e.g. Governance & Interoperability)
- Interdisciplinary vehicle with Standards bodies
 - To provide exchange, recommendations, papers and other areas of standardization for consistent future frameworks (e.g Liason Catergory A status with ISO, & CEN-CENELEC, ETSI, ITU coming soon)
- Help centre for the members with "de-facto" Standards

 Help members focus on standards issues as they focus on their work topics, and to provide them with knowledge about the Standardization styles, rules and copyrighting recommendations.




