





**Nuclear South Asia: A Guide to India, Pakistan, and the Bomb**

***Enrolling in the Course***


**Step 1:** Enter [www.nuclearlearning.org](http://www.nuclearlearning.org) into the URL bar of your web browser. This will direct you to *Nuclear South Asia*'s homepage.



**Step 2:** Click "Enroll for free," which is located in the blue box below the course title.



**Step 3:** Enter your first name, last name, and email address. Then create a password and click “Create Account.” This is all the information that is required to enroll in the course.



**Step 4:** Once you have clicked “Create Account,” you will be logged into the *Nuclear South Asia* course dashboard. The course content will appear on the right side of the screen, beginning with the course checklist. Remember: always click the green “Next” button to ensure your progress is tracked accurately.
