The First 10% for other churches to THRIVE

It is the practice of First Christian Church to generously give to ministry and mission outside of our church. (The annual percentage given away is actually 23%!) Giving 10% reflects the standard of generosity we are called to practice in our individual households.

Our commitment in the 2018-19 **THRIVE** Campaign is to give away the first 10% of monies received to help other churches around our country "thrive" in their communities.

In 2018, First Christian Church accepted the responsibility for leadership of Disciple Heritage Fellowship (DHF). Through DHF, we are charged to support these churches with leadership development, mission, and vision clarification. We provide strategic planning to best steward the ministry opportunities God has given them. The first 10% of monies received through Thrive will go directly to leading other churches around the country. Your gift will help other congregations thrive!

Debt Elimination for First Christian Church to THRIVE

The ability to lead other churches effectively starts with leading ourselves purposefully. For decades, First Christian Church has stepped out in faith to generously fund new ministry opportunities in our community. A linchpin in allowing us to put more resources into new ministries is the freeing up of resources through debit elimination.

Through your generosity in our 2015 campaign, EMPOWER, we celebrated reducing our debt from \$2.7 million to \$1.9 million. Our commitment in the 2018-19 **THRIVE** Campaign is to eliminate the remaining \$1.9 million debt, freeing First Christian Church to "thrive" in new ministry opportunities.
