

Make Your Own Science News Update

1. Choose your topic.

What makes you curious? What do you get excited about? Pick a topic or science news story you'd like to explore and share with other people!

2. Find a focus.

Your report can't cover everything, so decide what you'd like to focus on. Maybe there's a question you'd like to answer?

3. Carry out research.

What do you need to create your report? Use the internet, books, and magazines to gather information. You could even interview an expert on your topic.

4. Think about content.

What key points do you want to cover? What would you like people to learn?

5. Think about structure.

How will you start your report to get people interested? Make sure it also has a middle and an ending.

6. Write your report.

Use the **News Update Template** to create your report. You can write on the lines and draw illustrations or paste images in the boxes.

7. Optional: Present your report!

You could share your report with your classmates, friends or family. Why not...

- Hand out copies of your report, or...
- Read aloud the written report and display any visuals, or...
- Make a recording (video or audio) of you presenting your report.
