Materials:

- Found objects such as cardboard, plastic bottles, and tubes
- Glue
- Tape
- Scissors
- Clay (optional)

Process:

Begin by experimenting with your found materials. Use scissors and tape to combine these materials or transform them. Consider attaching parts together to form a figure or something from your imagination to make your sculpture.
