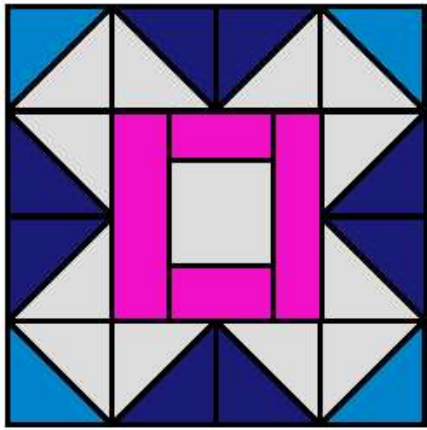


Snowy Day Quilt Sampler

Block 2



Unfinished Size 16.5 x 16.5 inches

Cutting Instructions:

Color A (Navy):

4 - 5.25 x 5.25 inch squares

Color B (Pink):

2 - 2.5 x 4.5 inch strips

2 - 2.5 x 8.5 inch strips

Color C (Teal):

2 - 5.25 x 5.25 inch squares

Color D (Grey):

1 - 4.5 x 4.5 inch square

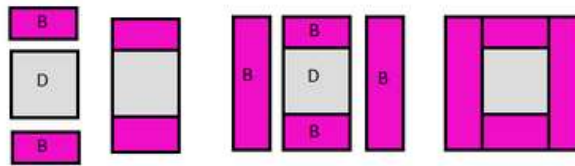
6 - 5.25 x 5.25 inch squares

*All seams in pattern are 1/4 inch

Sewing Instructions:

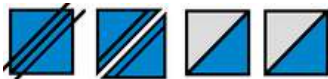
1. Take the Color D - 4.5 inch square, with right sides together, sew the Color B - 2.5 x 4.5 inch strips to the bottom and the top of the square. Press seams to the attached strips.

Then sew the Color B - 2.5 x 8.5 inch strips the left and the right sides of the block, with right sides together. Press seams toward the strips. (Shown below)

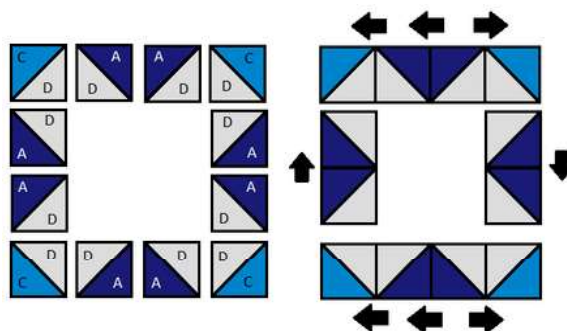


2. Using the 5.25 inch squares, match up your square combinations (see below), right sides together. Make a mark from one corner to another diagonally on the square. Pin in place. Sew 1/4 inch from the drawn line on both sides. Cut down the center line. Press seam to the darker fabric. The blocks will be slightly larger than needed. Trim all blocks to 4.5 x 4.5 inches.

Combinations needed: 4 - D/A and 2 - D/C

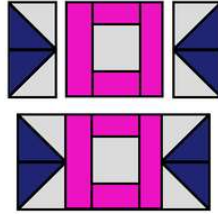


3. Lay out the following squares (shown below). Sew the 4 top squares together to make a strip. Sew each side section to each other to make a strip. Sew the bottom 4 squares together to make a strip. Press seams as the arrows show on diagrams on the right.

4. Take the two part sections from step 3 and the square from step 1. With right sides together, sew the two part sections to the left and right of the square from step 1 as shown below. Press toward the inner square.



5. Take the two long strips from step 3. With right sides together, sew one of the sections to the top and the other to the bottom, as shown below. Press toward the center.

Yay! You've finished your second block!
