
Snowy Day Quilt Sampler Block 7




Unfinished Size 16.5 x 16.5 inches


Sewing Instructions:

1. Using the 5.25 inch squares, match up 3 Color D squares and 3 Color B squares, with right sides together. Make a mark from one corner to another diagonally on the square. Pin in place. Sew 1/4 inch from the drawn line on both sides. Cut down the center line. Press seam to the darker fabric. The blocks will be slightly larger than needed. Trim all blocks to 4.5 x 4.5 inches.

2. Lay out your half square triangle and 1 - 4.5 x 4.5 inch square, Color B, as shown below. With right sides together, sew squares together to form rows, like shown below. Press seams to the right.



4. With right sides together, sew the side section to the right side of the block. Press toward the big square block. Then sew the top section to the big block. Press seam to the big block. Yay! You've finished your seventh block!



Cutting Instructions:

Color A (Navy):

1 - 2.5 x 8.5 inch strip

1 - 2.5 x 10.5 inch strip

Color B (Pink):

3 - 5.25 x 5.25 inch squares

1 - 4.5 inch square

Color C (Teal):

1 - 2.5 x 4.5 inch strip

1 - 2.5 x 6.5 inch strip

Color D (Grey):

3 - 5.25 x 5.25 inch squares

1 - 4.5 x 4.5 inch squares

1 - 2.5 x 12.5 inch strip

1 - 2.5 x 10.5 inch strip

1 - 2.5 x 8.5 inch strip

1 - 2.5 x 6.5 inch strip

3. Lay out your Color D - 4.5 inch square, Color C -2.5 x 4.5 inch and 2.5 x 6.5 inch strips, Color D -2.5 x 6.5 inch and 2.5 x 8.5 inch strip, Color A - 2.5 x 8.5 inch and 2.5 x 10.5 inch strips, Color D 2.5 x 10.5 inch and 2.5 x 12.5 inch strips, as shown below. With right sides together, sew strips on in the order of 1 thru 8. Press seams toward the attached strip.
