	AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Brent Trout, renaming the Planning Department and authorizing fee waivers; amending City of Topeka Code § 2.30.090; 2.50.010; 2.50.020; 14.20.060, subsection 109.6; 14.55.150, and repealing §§ 2.50.030, 2.50.040, and 2.50.060.	
9 10	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:	
11	Section 1. That section 2.30.090, Planning department created, of The Code	
12	of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:	
13	Planning and development department created.	
14	(a) There is hereby created a department of planning and development. The	
15	director of planning and development shall be appointed by the city manager. The city	
16	manager, pursuant to Charter Ordinance No. 94, Section 1 (Appendix A, Section A2-	
17	54), shall be responsible for supervising and evaluating the performance of the planning	
18	and development director of planning. The planning and development director shall be	
19	responsible for the overall operation of the department, including comprehensive	
20	planning, zoning, transportation planning, and development services.	
21	The director of planning shall be responsible for the overall operation of the planning	
22	department.	
23	(b) All references in the Code to "planning director" or "director of planning"	
24	shall mean the director of planning and development.	
25	(c) All references in the Code to "planning department" shall mean the	
26	department of planning and development.	
27	Section 2. That section 2.50.010, Created, of The Code of the City of Topeka,	
28	Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:	

Created Development services division.

There is hereby created a building code enforcement development services division. This division shall be under the general supervision of the planning director of planning and development and as such shall be an administrative division within the planning department of planning and development.

Section 3. That section 2.50.020, Sections enumerated, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sections enumerated Duties; director.

- (a) The building code enforcement development services division shall consist of the following named sections: be responsible for all permit, inspection, and enforcement functions related to building and trade codes.
- (a) Building Inspection. A building inspection section which shall consist of a building inspector and such number of assistant inspectors as may be authorized.
- (b) Electrical Inspection. An electrical inspection section which shall consist of an electrical inspector and such number of assistant inspectors as may be authorized.
- (c) Plumbing Inspection. A plumbing inspection section which shall consist of a plumbing inspector and such number of assistant inspectors as may be authorized.
- (d) Mechanical Inspection. A mechanical inspection section which shall consist of a mechanical inspector and such number of assistant inspectors as may be authorized.
- (b) The director of development services shall be responsible for the discharge of division duties imposed by this chapter and other ordinances imposing duties upon the development services division. The director of development services shall be responsible to the director of planning and development.

(c) The director of development services shall be authorized, subject to the approval of the director of planning and development, to utilize expert technical advisors when deemed necessary to determine any question arising under the ordinances relating to the duties of the development services division.

<u>Section 4</u>. That section 2.50.030, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed.

Code enforcement director - Devotion to duty.

The code enforcement director shall, during his term of office, devote full time to the official duties and shall not be engaged or employed directly in any building business, nor enter into any contract for the design or construction of any building for another or for furnishing any materials, drawings or specifications therefor.

<u>Section 5</u>. That section 2.50.040, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed.

Powers and duties generally

(a) The director of development services shall be the head of the building code enforcement division and shall be responsible for the performance of the duties of the subordinate members and employees of the division. The director of development services shall be authorized and empowered to perform the duties imposed upon any inspector or assistant inspector of the building code enforcement division, any ordinance of the city to the contrary notwithstanding. In the discharge of duties, the director of development services shall be directly responsible to the planning director and shall make such reports of the affairs of the building code enforcement division as may be required by the planning director.

(b) The director of development services shall have such other duties as may be
imposed by this chapter and other ordinances imposing special duties upon the building
code enforcement division.

<u>Section 6</u>. That section 2.50.060, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed.

Expert technical advisors.

The code enforcement director shall be authorized, subject to the approval of the planning director, to utilize expert technical advisors when deemed necessary to determine any question arising under the ordinances relating to the duties of the building code enforcement division.

Section 7. That section 14.20.060, subsection 109.6, waiver of fees, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Waiver of fees

109.6 Waiver of fees. Building permit fees and plan review fees as required by this section for building projects with a total valuation of five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) or more may be modified by the city manager to a lesser amount, such modification not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the scheduled fees provided the city manager determines the building project encourages economic development and creation of jobs. Modifications of building permit fees and plan review fees which exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the scheduled fees shall be approved by the governing body. However, no modification of building permit fees and plan review fees shall be made

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if: 1) the applicant utilizes other available tax incentives and/or 2) the subject property is exempt from real estate taxation.

109.6.1 Building permit and plan review fees for projects identified by the governing body shall be waived provided and to the extent the Joint Economic Development Organization reimburses the City for such fees.

109.6.2. The city manager is authorized to consider fee waivers in cases of :(1) emergency situations; and (2) affordable or charitable housing projects where materials and labor are donated.

<u>Section 8</u>. That section 14.55.150, Schedule of permit fees, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Schedule of permit fees; waiver.

Section R108.2, Schedule of permit fees, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following provisions shall be substituted therefor:

(a) On buildings, structures, electrical, gas, mechanical and plumbing systems or alterations requiring a permit, a fee for each permit shall be paid as required, in accordance with the following schedule:

120	(b) Working without permit. Whenever work that requires a permit has
121	commenced without a permit, an amount equal to twice the normal permit fee shall be
122	paid before the permit is issued.
123	(c) Investigation fee. All site investigations made by inspectors of work going
124	on without permits will require an additional \$50.00 investigation fee, in addition to any
125	other fees, be added to the final permit fee if it is determined that the work being done at
126	the site does indeed require a permit and no application has been made.
127	(d) The city manager is authorized to consider fee waivers in
128	cases of : (1) emergency situations; and (2) affordable or charitable
129	housing projects where materials and labor are donated.
130	Section 9. That original §§ 2.30.090; 2.50.010; 2.50.020; 14.20.060,
131	subsection 109.6; and 14.55.150 of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, are
132	hereby specifically repealed.
133	Section 10. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
134	passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
135	Section 11. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules,
136	or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.
137	Section12. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared
138	invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this
139	ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
