6	WHEREAS, the City of Topeka owns and operates a municipal water utility; and	
7	WHEREAS, the City of Topeka has historically sold water to rural water districts	
8	pursuant to negotiated contracts; and	
9	WHEREAS,	such wholesaling of water to rural water districts provides the
10	opportunity for the City to reinforce the City's water customer base and to stabilize the	
11	City's water rate structure.	
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka that it	
13	supports the sale of water to rural water districts subject to negotiated contracts which	
14	contain acceptable terms and conditions.	
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka that acceptable	
16	terms and conditions in rural water district contracts for the sale of water shall include, but	
17	not be limited to the following:	
18	1. Estab	lishing "reasonable value" of the rural water district water system;
19	2. Requi	iring installation of rural water district waterlines in accordance with City
20	design standards for those areas which are within three miles of the City boundaries;	
21	3. Estab	lishing a minimum water consumption amount;
22	4. Estab	lishing the service areas of both the City of Topeka and the rural water
23	district to differentiate between the urban and rural service areas, based on the current	
24	Growth Management Plan published by the Metropolitan Planning Department;	

25 5. Establishing a maximum number of service connections based on those 26 required for a typical rural water service provider. 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the public works department shall, no later than 28 January 31 of each year, present an annual report outlining the current status of all rural 29 water district contracts for the sale of water and the results of any contract negotiations 30 during the previous calendar year. BE IT RESOLVED that City of Topeka Resolution No. 6870 is hereby specifically 31 32 rescinded.
