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4 RESOLUTION OF ADVISABILITY AND AUTHORIZATION NO. 7372

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7 A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor Harry Felker authorizing Improvement  
8 Project No. 60206-02 H, as more specifically described herein.  
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10 WHEREAS, the City Council has received a petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a04,  
11 containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in the improvement district  
12 hereinafter described; and

13 WHEREAS, seven (7) days have elapsed since the filing of said petition.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,  
15 Kansas, that it finds Improvement Project No. 60206-02 H, hereinafter described, to be  
16 advisable and does hereby authorize and order said improvement to be made in  
17 accordance with its findings as follows:

19 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

20 To pave:

21  
22 SE Gilmore Street from the existing pavement at the south line of Lot 7,  
23 Block "B," Rolling Meadows Subdivision No. 5 northerly to the existing  
24 pavement at the north line of Lot 1, Block "C," Rolling Meadows Subdivision  
25 No. 5, and SE Golden Avenue from the existing pavement at the south line  
26 of Lot 1, Block "E," Rolling Meadows Subdivision No. 5 northerly and  
27 westerly to the westerly line of Lot 1, Block "C," Rolling Meadows Subdivision  
28 No. 5 with 29 foot wide pavement including concrete curb and gutter,  
29 sidewalk ramps, storm drainage facilities, engineering, and all other  
30 contingencies needed to complete the project.

33 B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:

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35 Lots 4 through 7, Block "B"; Lot 1, Block "C"; Lots 1 through 9, Block "D";  
36 Lots 1 through 8, Block "E"; Rolling Meadows Subdivision No. 5, in the City

37 of Topeka, Kansas.

40 \$226,800.00

45 On a unit basis for all lots or parcels which are included in the described  
46 improvement district.

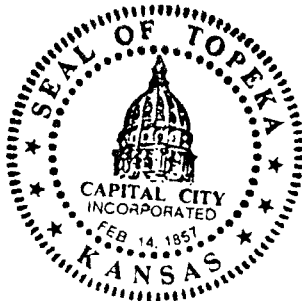
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48 E. APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS:
