

RESOLUTION NO. 7416

A RESOLUTION introduced by Councilmember Clark Duffy authorizing a study of improvements to certain public buildings and providing for the payment of the costs of the study and the improvements.

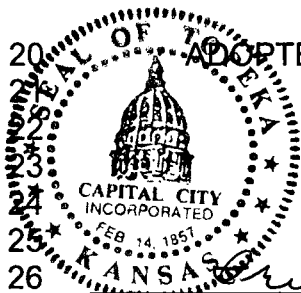
WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-1736 provides, in part, that any city in the State of Kansas may alter, repair, reconstruct, remodel, replace or make additions to a public building or buildings.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS pursuant to the authority vested in the City of Topeka by K.S.A. (2002 Supp.) 75-37,125, the City shall retain an energy conservation contractor through the normal bid process to conduct a study that will be paid from acquired energy cost savings.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the energy conservation contractor shall determine improvements in "energy conservation measures" as defined in K.S.A. (2002 Supp.) 75-37,125 that can be made to public buildings owned by the City which would be paid in full by acquired energy cost savings guaranteed by the energy conservation contractor.
