5 6	WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas has been informed by
7	Accessible Space, Inc., and the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, Mid America
8	Chapter, that applications for U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development
9	(HUD) funds were have been provisionally approved for the development of a
10	housing project to be located just north of the intersection of SE 28 th Street and SE
11	Glenside Court; and
12	WHEREAS, the developer has submitted and agrees to be bound by all terms
13	and conditions contained in a Section 811 Agreement with HUD; and
14	WHEREAS, the housing development just north of SE 28 th Street and SE
15	Glenside Court will contain approximately twenty (20) units; and
16	WHEREAS, all units in this project will be targeted to adults between the ages
17	of eighteen (18) and sixty-two (62) years of age with physical disabilities; and
18	WHEREAS, all housing units will have the following: card access security
19	system, automatic power entry doors, complete sprinkler system, on-site laundry,
20	community room, an accessible kitchen and bathroom, bath or wheel-in shower
21	option, accessible light switches and outlets, and lever door handles; and
22	WHEREAS, the development of all the housing units in this project will consist
23	of new construction; and

24	WHEREAS, the developer has requested waiver of building fees and plan
25	review charges by the City of Topeka in the amount of approximately twelve
26	thousand dollars (\$12,000.00).
27	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,
28	Kansas, that it supports the development of the aforesaid housing development just
29	north of the intersection of SE 28 th Street and SE Glenside Court in our community,
30	subject to all applicable City regulatory requirements, and supports the waiver of
31	building inspection fees and plan review charges. This Resolution is effective unti
32	January 1, 2005. In the event that any of the above recitations should change prior
33	to the issuance of a building permit, this Resolution is null and void.
34	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that City of Topeka Resolution No. 7345 is
35	hereby rescinded.
