McClinton declaring the eligibility of the City of Topeka to submit an application to the Kansas Department of Transportation for use of transportation enhancement funds set forth by the Federal Transportation Equity Act for the 21 <sup>st</sup> century for Improvement Project No. 86235-04, which provides for the Washburn/Lane pedestrian lighting project and authorizing Mayor James A. McClinton to sign the application.
11	WHEREAS, the City of Topeka, Kansas, has the legal authority to apply for, receive,
12	and administer federal, state, and other monies through Home Rule Power under the
13	Constitution of the State of Kansas and authorized by K.S.A. 12-1662, regarding the
14	expenditure of federal aid to public agencies; and
15	WHEREAS, the City of Topeka, Kansas, desires to submit an application to the
16	Kansas Department of Transportation for transportation enhancement program funds set
17	forth by the Federal Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century; and
18	WHEREAS, the City of Topeka, Kansas, is participating in the Kansas Department of
19	Transportation's Transportation Enhancement Program set forth by the Federal
20	Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century; and
21	WHEREAS, Federal monies are available under a transportation enhancement
22	program set forth by the Federal Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century,
23	administered by the State of Kansas, Department of Transportation, for the purpose of
24	Historic, Scenic and Environmental, and Pedestrian and Bicycle projects; and
25	WHEREAS, After appropriate public input and due consideration, the Governing
26	Body of City of Topeka, Kansas has recommended that an application be submitted to the
27	State of Kansas for Improvement Project No. 86235-04, which provides for pedestrian

28	lighting on Washburn and Lane streets, hereinafter referred to as the Washburn/Lane
29	Pedestrian Lighting Project.
30	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,
31	Kansas, that:
32	Section 1. That the City of Topeka, Kansas does hereby authorize Mayor James A.
33	McClinton to submit an application to the Kansas Department of Transportation for
34	transportation enhancement program funds set forth by the Federal Transportation Equity
35	Act for the 21st Century on behalf of the citizens of City of Topeka, Kansas.
36	Section 2. That the City of Topeka, Kansas, hereby assures the Kansas
37	Department of Transportation that sufficient funding for the construction of the
38	Washburn/Lane Pedestrian Lighting Project is available.
39	Section 3. That the City of Topeka, Kansas, hereby assures the Kansas
40	Department of Transportation that sufficient funding for the operation and maintenance of
41	the Washburn/Lane Pedestrian Lighting Project will be available for the life of the project.
42	Section 4. That the City of Topeka, Kansas, hereby assures the Kansas
43	Department of Transportation that the City of Topeka, Kansas, will have title or permanent
44	easement to the Washburn/Lane Pedestrian Lighting Project by the time of project letting.
45	Section 5. That the Mayor James A. McClinton of City of Topeka, Kansas, is
46	authorized to sign the application to the Kansas Department of Transportation for
47	transportation enhancement program funds set forth by the Federal Transportation Equity
48	Act for the 21st Century on behalf of the citizens of City of Topeka, Kansas. The Mayor
49	James A. McClinton is also authorized to submit additional information as may be required

50	and act as the official representative of the City of Topeka in this and subsequent related
51	activities.
52	Section 6. That the City of Topeka, Kansas, hereby assures the Kansas
53	Department of Transportation that the City of Topeka, Kansas, is willing and able to, if the
54	Washburn/Lane Pedestrian Lighting Project is selected for funding, administer the
55	designing, letting and construction of the Washburn/Lane Pedestrian Lighting Project.
