

RESOLUTION NO. 7574

A RESOLUTION introduced by Mayor James A. McClinton authorizing expenditures from the Crime Prevention Fund.

WHEREAS, the City Council established a crime prevention fund in Ordinance No. 17796.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 17796 directs that expenditures from this fund be for crime prevention services and be specifically authorized by resolution of the City Council, and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously passed Resolution No. 7268 authorizing certain expenditures from the Crime Prevention fund, and

WHEREAS, the City Council and the Chief of Police desire to make expenditures from the Crime Prevention Fund in addition to those set forth in Resolution No. 7268;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Chief of Police is authorized to expend monies from the crime prevention fund for the following purpose:

An Advocacy program called Rights, Responsibility, Advocacy and Personal Safety (RRAPS) to be established carried on by the Topeka Association Retarded Citizens (TARC), such funds to be expended only for cost of materials for this program, not to exceed \$4500.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any expenditures from the crime prevention fund shall not be used for personnel or operating costs of any agency receiving such funds.
