12	WHEREAS, the City of Topeka has the legal authority to apply for, receive, and
13	administer federal, state, and other monies through Home Rule Power under the
14	Constitution of the State of Kansas and authorized by K.S.A. 12-1662, regarding the
15	expenditure of federal aid to public agencies; and
16	WHEREAS, the City of Topeka desires to submit an application to the Kansas
17	Department of Transportation for transportation enhancement program funds set forth by
18	the Federal Transportation Equity Act for the 21 st Century; and
19	WHEREAS, the City of Topeka is participating in the Kansas Department of
20	Transportation's Transportation Enhancement Program set forth by the Federal
21	Transportation Equity Act for the 21 st Century; and
22	WHEREAS, federal monies are available under a transportation enhancement
23	program set forth by the Federal Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century,
24	administered by the State of Kansas, Department of Transportation, for the purpose of
25	Historic, Scenic and Environmental, and Pedestrian and Bicycle projects; and
26	WHEREAS, after appropriate public input and due consideration, the City Council
27	has recommended that an application be submitted to the State of Kansas for the Shunga
28	Trail Project.
29	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

32	Section 1. That the City Council does hereby authorize the City Manager to
33	submit an application to the Kansas Department of Transportation for transportation
34	enhancement program funds set forth by the Federal Transportation Equity Act for the 21st
35	Century on behalf of the citizens of the City of Topeka.
36	Section 2. That the City Council hereby assures the Kansas Department of
37	Transportation that sufficient funding for the construction of the Shunga Trail Project is
38	available.
39	Section 3. That the City Council hereby assures the Kansas Department of
40	Transportation that sufficient funding for the operation and maintenance of the Shunga
41	Trail Project will be available for the life of the project.
42	Section 4. That the City Council hereby assures the Kansas Department of
43	Transportation that the City of Topeka will have title or permanent easement to the Shunga
44	Trail Project by the time of project letting.
45	Section 5. That the City Manager is authorized to sign the application to the
46	Kansas Department of Transportation for transportation enhancement program funds set
47	forth by the Federal Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century on behalf of the citizens
48	of the City of Topeka. The City Manager is also authorized to submit additional information
49	as may be required and act as the official representative of the City of Topeka in this and
50	subsequent related activities.
51	Section 6. That the City Council hereby assures the Kansas Department of
52	Transportation that the City Council is willing and able to, if the Shunga Trail Project is

53	selected for funding, administer the designing, letting and construction of the Shunga Trail
54	Project.
