4 RESOLUTION OF ADVISABILITY AND AUTHORIZATION NO. 7764

7 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Neil Dobler authorizing Street  
8 Improvement Project No. 60611-03 located at approximately  
9 S.W. 47<sup>th</sup> Court, S.W. Misty Harbor Drive and S.W. Rolling  
10 Court as more specifically described herein.  
11

12 WHEREAS, the City Clerk has received a petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a04,  
13 containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in the improvement district  
14 hereinafter described; and

15 WHEREAS, seven (7) days have elapsed since the filing of said petition.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,  
17 Kansas, that it finds Street Improvement Project No. 60611-03, hereinafter described, to be  
18 advisable and does hereby authorize and order said improvement to be made in  
19 accordance with its findings as follows:

21 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:  
22

23 To pave the adjacent streets (S.W. 47<sup>th</sup> Court, S.W. Misty Harbor Drive and  
24 S.W. Rolling Court) with 29 feet pavement, included concrete curb and  
25 gutter, sidewalk ramps, storm drainage facilities, and all other contingencies  
26 needed to complete the project.

28 B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:

30 Lots 10-33, Block D, and Lots 9-26, Block F, all in the Alexander  
31 Place Subdivision, Topeka, Kansas

33 C. ESTIMATED OR PROBABLE COST:

D. METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:

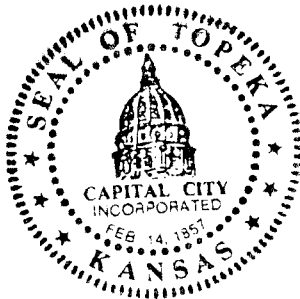
On a unit basis for all lots or individual dwelling sites that are included in the improvement district.
