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7 A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr.,
8 authorizing Improvement Project No. 60625-00 as more
9 specifically described herein.
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11 WHEREAS, the City Clerk has received a petition, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a04,
12 containing the signatures of the owners of 100% of the area in the improvement district
13 hereinafter described; and

14 WHEREAS, seven (7) days have elapsed since the filing of said petition.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka,
16 Kansas, that it finds Improvement Project No. 60625-00, hereinafter described, to be
17 advisable and does hereby authorize and order said improvement to be made in
18 accordance with its findings as follows:

19 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:
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21 To pave: SW Shenandoah Road from approximately 190 feet South of
22 SW 43rd Terrace to SW 46th Street and SW Stonybrook Drive from
23 Shenandoah Road to the South line of Lauren's Bay Villas, with 29 foot wide
24 pavement, storm sewer and all other contingencies needed to complete
25 project.
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27 B. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:
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29 Lots 1 through 14, Block A, Lauren's Bay Villas, City of Topeka, Shawnee
30 County, Kansas
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32 Lots 1 through 7, Block B, Lauren's Bay Villas, City of Topeka, Shawnee
33 County, Kansas
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35 Lots 1 through 9, Block C, Lauren's Bay Villas, City of Topeka, Shawnee
36 County, Kansas
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Lots 1 through 10, Block D, Lauren's Bay Villas, City of Topeka, Shawnee County, Kansas

C. ESTIMATED OR PROBABLE COST:

\$880,707.00

D. PROPOSED METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:

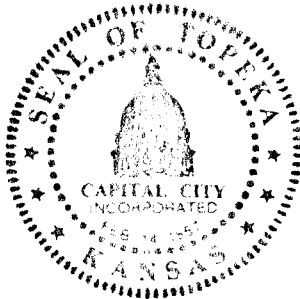
On a basis for all lots or individual dwelling sites which are included in the improvement district.
