

RESOLUTION NO. 7808

A RESOLUTION introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr. relating to and authorizing Project No. 24117-B which provides for the removal and replacement of damaged or hazardous concrete/brick sidewalks throughout the city as more specifically described herein.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, that it finds the following described public improvement to be necessary and in the public interest and does hereby authorize Project No. 24117-B with a project budget summarized herein and more fully set forth on the attachment hereto:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project involves the removal and replacement of damaged or hazardous concrete/brick sidewalks throughout the city. The project assists in the funding of repairs for the residential sidewalks by providing funding for 50% of the project cost. Property owners must pay their share of the repair cost prior to the beginning of construction.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$200,000.00

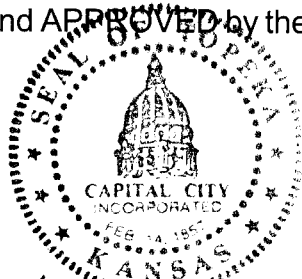
C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:
