17	implications and the ability of the City to fund such projects.
18	Implementation of the projects contained in the 2007-2008 Capital Improvement
19	Budget shall be approved by applicable ordinance or resolution as required by law. This
20	resolution shall be rescinded and a new resolution adopted when the project budget
21	exceeds the amount identified.
22	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 7884 is hereby rescinded.
23	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this resolution shall become effective upon

passage and approval by the City Council.
