

**RESOLUTION NO. 8646**

A RESOLUTION introduced by Interim City Manager Doug Gerber approving the 2017 Neighborhood Grant & Beautification Program grants (Neighborhood Partnership Program)

WHEREAS, the City of Topeka, Kansas, in its efforts to enhance and improve the quality of life in area neighborhoods, allocated \$25,000 of 2017 General Fund funds for the Neighborhood Grant & Beautification Program (Neighborhood Partnership Program); and

WHEREAS, the Neighborhood Partnership Program Grant Review Committee, comprised of one City staff member and three community representatives, evaluated the applications received for Neighborhood Partnership Program grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the Neighborhood Partnership Program Grant Review Committee recommends the following funding allocations:

Huntington Condominiums – “First Impressions” - \$2,500  
Potwin- Potwin Circles Holiday Display - \$2,400

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, that the Governing Body supports and approves the recommended funding allocations from the Neighborhood Partnership Program Grant Review Committee.
