7	WHEREAS, the 2016-2020 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) has been prepared													
8	by staff; and													
9	WHEREAS, the purpose of the CIP is to plan for and prioritize public improvement													
10	projects over the next five years; and													
11	WHEREAS, the 2016-2018 Capital Improvement Budget (CIB) has been prepared													
12	by staff in addition to budgets for specific projects ready for implementation; and													
13	WHEREAS, the document entitled "2016-2020 Proposed Capital Improvemen													
14	Plan," dated March 10, 2015 ("CIP Book") contains the CIP, CIB, and all associated project													
15	budgets and is attached herein and incorporated by reference; and													
16	WHEREAS, for purposes of planning and allocating resources the City Counc													
17	should consider and approve the CIP and CIB and the specific CIB project budgets which													
18	are ready for implementation.													
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council takes the following													
20	actions:													
21	1. The CIP. The Council approves and adopts the 2016-2020 Capita													
22	Improvement Program contained in the CIP Book at pages 7-9.													
23	2. The CIB. The Council also approves and adopts the 2016-2018 Capita													
24	Improvement Budget contained in the CIP Book at pages 7-9.													
25	3. 2016-2018 CIB Project Budgets. Sections A12-17 and A12-25 of the Code													
26	of the City of Topeka require Council approval of all project budgets for public													
27	improvements.													

- (a) G.O. Bonded Projects. With regard to the projects identified on pages 13, 15, 22 through 30, 32, 33, 34, 37, 38, 39, and 43 in the CIP Book, the Council finds that the public improvements described are necessary and serve the public interest. Accordingly, the Council authorizes, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka, such projects and approves each project budget not previously approved in Resolution No. 8625. No project budget shall exceed the total budget amount identified in the CIP Book without Council approval.
- (b) G.O. Bonded Project/Fire Equipment. With regard to the projects identified on pages 17 and 18 in the CIP Book, the Council finds that the fire equipment described therein is necessary and serves the public interest. Accordingly, the Council authorizes such projects and approves each project budget not previously approved in Resolution No. 8625. No project budget shall exceed the total budget amount identified in the CIP Book without Council approval.

Moreover, the Council intends to acquire the fire-fighting equipment and pay the cost by issuing general obligation bonds maturing not more than 15 years from their date of issuance as authorized by K.S.A. 12-110c. Pursuant to K.S.A. 12-110c, the Council directs the City Clerk to publish a notice of its intention to acquire equipment that has not previously been the subject of a notice of intention, stating the cost and the City's intention to issue general obligation bonds. The notice shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official City newspaper. If, within 60 days following the last date of publication, a petition signed by not less than 5% of the qualified electors of the City of Topeka is filed with the City Clerk, no such bonds shall be issued until the matter of whether to issue general obligation bonds has been approved by a majority of the qualified electors of the City voting at an election called pursuant to the general bond law.
