5 6	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA,

8	Section 1.	Pursuant to state law, alcoholic liquor may be consumed at a special	
9	event to be held on designated public streets, alleys, and sidewalks when a temporary		
10	permit has been issued by the Kansas Division of Alcohol Beverage Control (ABC) and the		
11	governing body has approved the event as required by K.S.A. 41-719 and 41-2645 and		
12	amendments thereto.		
13	Section 2.	Having considered the request of the sponsor of the Sacred Heart-St.	
14	Joseph Parish Germanfest 2016 to allow the possession and consumption of alcoholic		
15	liquor, the governing body hereby approves the event to be held on June 4 between the		
16	hours of 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. and on June 5 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00		
17	p.m. provided the sponsor secures a temporary permit from ABC and complies with all		
18	state laws and ordinances regulating alcoholic liquor.		
19	Section 3.	The following streets and alleys shall be closed to motor vehicle traffic	
20	during the dates a	nd times identified in Section 2: Portions of NE Freeman Avenue from	
21	Seward Avenue to	south line of church (312 NE Freeman Avenue), NE Rowley Street from	
22	Seward Avenue to	south line of Greeley Street, Greeley Street from Rowley to alley, and	
23	an east-west alley south and parallel with Seward Avenue from Rowley Street to Twiss		
24	Avenue as designa	ated on the map attached hereto as Exhibit A. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-	

719 and 41-2645, the sponsor shall ensure that the area in which alcoholic liquor is

possessed or consumed is clearly marked by signs, a posted map or other means		
("Designated Barricaded Area").		
Section 4. Event attendees may purchase, possess and consume alcoholic		
beverages within the Designated Barricaded Area. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719, no alcoholic		
liquor may be removed from Designated Barricaded Area or consumed inside vehicles		
while on public streets or alleys at the event.		
Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force after its approval by		
the governing body.
