Executive Committee meeting – 6th February 2019

Minutes of the Meeting

The PTA Executive committee meeting was held on 6th of February 2019 as scheduled. The school Vice President Mrs.Uma Panse, the school Director Dr.Ashwini Kulkarni, the school Principal Mrs. Sundari jaishankar , the parents and teachers were present for the meeting.

1. The school Vice President, Mrs.Uma Panse welcomed the PTA members and shared the activities conducted in the school through a Power point presentation, which was highly appreciated by the parents.
2. The School Principal informed the parents that there is NO hike in the school fees for the coming academic year 2019 -20, whereas there would be a minimum of 15% hike in the school fees for the academic year 2020 -21.
3. One of the PTA executive members, Dr.Seema Jadhav requested the school to split 15% increase for two years rather than for one year. Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni, the school Director replied that the fee hike can only be levied once in 2 years and not every year as per the state government directives. The parents accepted the school's decision and Mr.Raghu Vidap, the PTA executive committee Vice Chairman, welcomed the decision.
4. The parents requested the school to make provision for distribution of textbooks and uniform in the month of April in the school premises. The school accepted the request and informed the parents that on the open days (26th & 27th April) the uniforms will be made available for the parents whereas the textbooks will be distributed in the last week of May. Added to it the Principal informed the parents that the parents are free to buy textbooks and Uniform from any supplier provided they are in accordance with the specifications laid down by the school.

5. The school brought to the parents notice that many of the parents delayed paying the fourth installment of the school fees. After discussion the parents suggested that ECS mode of fee payment would solve the problem. The school welcomed the suggestion and informed the parents that along with the existing challan system, ECS will be encouraged.
6. Mrs. Suhasini Gandhi, the PTA member showed concern over the bus charges. She requested the school to reduce the charges. The school replied saying that the school transport is outsourced and will hold talks with the contractors after analyzing the bus charges of other schools.
7. The grade VIII parent representative requested the school to allot time or period for doubt clearing session. The school accepted the request and informed the parents that the students can come on Saturdays for doubt clearance.
8. The meeting concluded with Vote of thanks proposed by the secretary of the PTA executive committee.
