MINUTES OF THE MEETING

The PTA Executive Committee Meeting was held on 13th of August 2018 at 8.30 a.m. in the school campus as scheduled. The School Vice-President, Mrs. Uma Panse, School Director, Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni, Principal, Mrs. J. Sivagama Sundari, the Executive committee members and teachers were present for the meeting.

Welcome Note –

The school Principal, Mrs. J. Sivagama Sundari welcomed the parents, shared the school achievements and presented the academic year plans for the year 2018-19.

Achievements –

- Congratulated the Grade X teachers & students for excellent Board results. 77 % of the students scored above 80 %.

- Internship program for Grade IX was a huge success. Students visited 16 firms for one week internship programme. Helped them to explore various professionals and understood requirement of each profession.
- School has been selected by NITI Aayog under Atal Innovation Mission to establish Atal Tinkering Lab. The students from Grade VI will be trained for robotics, electronics, and mechanics.

Academic Plans –

1. Class-wise parents orientation meeting were conducted to brief the teaching methodologies and activities conducted.
2. In house Nurse and Counselor appointed to take care of needy students.
3. Soft Skill training program to be continued for the classes VI to X.
4. Career Counselling Session planned for the students and parents of standard IX & X.
5. Teachers' Professional Development Programs are planned & conducted regularly.
6. Students' mass counselling sessions by Doctors, Psychologists, and Counselors are planned.
7. Parenting Sessions by clinical psychologists are planned.
8. Students will be trained for various interschool competitions, National & International Projects and sports events.
9. Social awareness programs are planned.
10. Picnics and Field Visits will be organized.
11. Quarterly newsletter and annual school magazine will be published. Students' editorial committee will be trained.
12. "DSK Karandak" – interschool sports event will be organized this year.
13. School Radio Programme will be arranged once in a quarter.
14. Additional CC TV's cameras installed for close monitoring and to enhance the security of the students.
15. Collaborated with 'Karadi Path' for Std. I to empower English Subject.
16. Collaborated with two educational solution companies for digital contents. All the classrooms from Nursery to Std VIII are digitalized. .
17. Installed 30 KW Solar Power plant to support energy requirement of the school.
18. Constructed new playground for Primary Section students.

19. Morning Sports Club for the students from 6.50 am to 7.50 am. Specialized coaches train the students for basketball, volleyball & athletics.
20. Evening sports club for skating, basketball & taekwondo.
21. Students of Grade VI coached for Homi Bhabha Exam and Grade III for IPM exam in school.
22. Dramatics Club introduced on Saturdays for students of standard V to VIII.
23. Regular test series are conducted for standard X students.
24. Students are enrolled for various competitive exams.
25. The school has purchased 10 School Cinemas (which is a short movie) to teach the students life skills.
26. Students will be trained in Self Defense Technique.
27. Transport Committee formed for the academic year 2018-19.
28. School Safety Committee formed. The Committee members are management representatives, Principal, coordinators, transport representatives, parent representative & student representative.

Feedback & Suggestions –

1. Mrs. Gandhi appreciated and thanked the school for having soft skill which has helped her children at home front.
2. Mr. Santosh Kulkarni suggested if the parents could also view the school cinema along with the students.
Ans. – The Principal responded saying that the students may not open up for discussion in front of their parents but assured to screen for the parents separately
3. Mr. Raghu Vidap suggested to install street lights on the approach road to the school as it is difficult to walk through the road at nights. He assured his assistance to get it done.
Ans. – The School accepted the proposal
4. Parents of Grade X are concerned about how to go about with the studies of their wards.
Ans. – Students will be guided by the teachers and soft skill teachers will conduct the time management session for them.
5. Mrs. Seema Jadhav requested the school to make provision for enrollment of students for 'Astronomy Olympiad Examination'.

Ans. – Minimum 30 participants are required for this Olympiad thus it could not happen this year but assured that the school will arrange it for the next academic year.

6. Mr. Raghu Vidap wanted more students to participate District level sports competitions.

Ans. – The students are already enrolled for various sports events to be held by DSO, Sakaal & AISM.

7. Mr. Raghu Vidap enquired about students' participation in various inter school competitions.

Ans. – The school encourages the students to participate in maximum number of competitions and trained for the same.

8. Mr. Raghu Vidap wanted to know about the medical checkups of the students in school.

Ans. – Medical checkups are conducted for classes I, IV, VII & IX in the month of August 2018. Parents who are doctors volunteer to conduct medical checkups.

9. Mr. Chougule suggested that students to be given exposure to financial intelligence and constructive use of technology.

Ans. – The school welcomed his suggestion and informed the members that a workshop on constructive use of technology is already scheduled for the students and will be conducted by the computer teacher.

10. The PTA members wanted to know how to communicate today's discussion of the meeting with other parents.
