THIS AGREEMENT THIS DAY ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE TOWN OF CORYDON, HARRISON COUNTY, INDIANA, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION EXISTING AND ORGANIZED UNDER THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF INDIANA, OF THE FIRST PART, -AND THE KELLER MANUFACTURING COMPANY, OF CORYDON, HARRISON COUNTY, INDIANA, A PRIVATE CORPORATION ORGANIZED UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF INDIANA, OF THE SECOND PART, IS TO THE EFFECT FOLLOWING, TO-WIT:---

That the said Party of the First Part by the terms and provisions of this agreement hereby grants and lets to the said Party of the Second Part the right and privilege to tap the Water Main belonging to the said Town of Corydon on North Market Street, in said town, and opposite the alley leading west from said North Market street, down to the Wagon Factory of said Party of the Second Part, and to attach to said Water Main at said point in said North Market street a six inch water pipe which the said Party of the Second Part is hereby granted the right to lay on and along said North Market street from said Water Main and down said alley to the said Wagon Factory of the said Party of the Second Part, said pipe to be laid under the ground, and the surface of the said street and alley to be put in good condition for travel and use by the public by said Party of the Second Part after the laying of said water pipe. And the said Party of the Second Part is to tap said Water Main, lay said pipe and put said street and alley in good condition at their own expense, and without expense to the said Party of the First Part. And the said Party of the First Part hereby grants to said Party of the Second Part the use of water from said water main to be conducted to ~~the~~ the Wagon Factory of said Party of the Second Part through said six inch pipe to be attached to said water main, as aforesaid, and the right and privilege of the use of said street and alley for the laying of said

six inch pipe, for a period of twenty years from this date, with the express agreement and understanding between said parties to this contract that said water to be thus supplied to the said Party of the Second Part, at their said Wagon Factory, is to be used to supply a Fire Sprinkling System to be placed in their said Wagon Factory, for the sole and only purpose of extinguishing fire at said Wagon Factory, should a fire occur, and said water thus supplied to be used for no other purpose whatever.

And in consideration of the said privilege granted by said Party of the First Part to the said Party of the Second Part, to tap said Water Main, lay said pipe and have the use of said water, and all said privileges, for the said period of twenty years, the said Party of the Second Part is to pay to the said Party of the First Part the sum of TEN DOLLARS in cash, which shall be accepted by the said Party of the First Part as full and complete payment for said privileges aforesaid for the said term of twenty years from this date.

In Witness Whereof the said Party of the First Part, the Town of Corydon, Indiana, by the Town Board of said Town, and the said Party of the Second Part, the said The Keller Manufacturing Company, of Corydon, Indiana, by its President and Secretary have hereunto signed this agreement and contract in duplicate

on this the 31st day of May, 1910.
