

June 12, 2017

The Town Council of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, met in the Town Hall, 113 North Oak Street, Corydon, Indiana, on the 12th day of June, 2017 at the hour of 7:30 p.m., in regular meeting pursuant to call in accordance with the rules of the Council.

The meeting was called to order by Eva North, who presided and the pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by the Council.

On call of the roll, the members of the Council were shown to be present or absent as follows:

Town Attorney Chris Byrd attended the meeting.

Mark Parks made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 22, 2017 Council meeting. Roger McGraw seconded the motion and the motion carried 3-0. John D. Kintner abstained from the vote due to his absence at the last meeting.

There was no activity in Planning & Zoning.

Amanda Bussabarger was on the agenda requesting a road block by the Corydon Central High School Cheer Squad. Varsity cheerleaders Emma and Anna Bussabarger spoke on behalf of Ms. Bussabarger who was unable to attend the meeting. The cheerleaders explained it was quite expensive to be a cheerleader and the fundraiser provided assistance to the squad members to purchase uniforms and pom poms. They requested the road block be set up at the intersections of North Capitol Ave and Walnut Street, and North Capitol Avenue and Chestnut Street on Saturday, June 2, 2017 from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm. The rain date is Saturday, June 9, 2017. Council Member Roger McGraw cautioned that no one under the age of sixteen (16) was allowed to collect money in the roadway. John D. Kintner made a motion to approve the roadblock with a second by Roger McGraw. The motion passed 4-0.

Roger McGraw made a motion to approve a bond for Christopher Avis 8/15/2017 thru 8/15/2018. John D. Kintner seconded the motion and the motion carried 4-0.

It was determined Item #7 on the agenda was a personnel matter and did not need to be brought up before the Town Council.

Eva North gave an update on the GIS project. She stated Matt Clarke of Midwestern Engineers had confirmed the water and sewer line data entry is complete and Danny Huff was in the process of entering the meters. She further added the inventory of the streets had been completed by Kenny Blum. The application for the 75/25% Community Crossing Grant from INDOT is due in July. Midwestern is going to enter all the updated drawings into the system. Buildings and locations will also be entered into the asset management program.

Ms. North also gave an update on the purchase of the Chase bank property. She stated the closing will be on Thursday, June 15, 2017.

Mark Parks made a motion to approve payments and sign bills. Roger McGraw seconded the motion and the motion carried 4-0.

There being no further business to come before the council and upon a motion made John D. Kintner and seconded by Mark Parks, the council adjourned with a 4-0 vote.
