RESOLUTION #1976-W-1

A motion was made, seconded and unanimously adopted as follows:

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the International Nursing Home, Inc., must install a fire sprinkler system in its facility located in the Town of Corydon in order to comply with federal standards, and

WHEREAS, there is no ample water line serving the facility at this time of sufficient capacity to supply the said sprinkler system, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Town of Corydon will not share in the cost of providing the said water line, and

WHEREAS, the said International Nursing Home, Inc., is willing to install such a water line at its own costs, and

WHEREAS, a letter of intent to dedicate the said water line to the Town of Corydon has been received, be it therefore resolved as follows:

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the said International Nursing Home, Inc., be and it now hereby is authorized and permitted to install a water line connecting its facility in the Town of Corydon with the town water system at a point approximately 1,340 feet east of the said facility upon the following terms and conditions:

(a) That 1340' of 6" cast iron, slip-joint pipe will be installed on the north side of county road at a minimum depth of 3½'.

(b) That an 8" valve be used where tap is made on the main water line.

(c) That a cross be used where the 6" main crosses the 4" main now serving the area.

(d) That on each side of the cross, a 4" gate valve be installed.

(e) That all work must be done to the approval of the Water Maintenance Superintendent.

(f) That all cost must be absorbed by International Nursing Home, Inc.

(g) That no rebates for later connections will be given International Nursing Home, Inc.

(h) That the grantee agree to pay a charge as set by the Public Service Commission for said service to sprinkler system.

This resolution shall be effective immediately.

We hereby request to extend the Town of Corydon water main to the Corydon Nursing Home property for the purpose of connecting a fire sprinkling system to service the nursing home, as per prior discussions with Mr. Steve Rucker, of the Fire Sprinkler Systems, Inc.

It is our understanding and agreement that after said water main, etc., is installed, that it shall be dedicated to the Town of Corydon.

If there are any other agreements that need to be signed, please forward them to us at once, as we have a deadline to meet in getting this system into service, so as not to jeopardize the operation of the Corydon Nursing Home.

Do you have any type of arrangement whereby any additional users to this new extended main would pay a fee to the Town, or to us for connecting to main, whereby we would be rebated monies to help defray the cost of this extended main. If so, we would be interested.


As time is of the essence, your full cooperation in this matter will be appreciated.
