

**NOTICE ON PROPOSED OFF-STREET
PARKING PROJECT FOR THE TOWN OF CORYDON**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, adopted Resolution No. 1966-P-1 on the 24th day of October, 1966, approving plats, descriptions, general plans or drawings, descriptions of land to be used, estimates of cost, and a method of financing certain off-street parking facilities, and by said Resolution found that it is necessary for the protection of the public safety and welfare that said off-street parking facilities be provided for and that the same will be of public utility and benefit to said Town of Corydon, and its citizens.

The foregoing are available for inspection at the office of the Clerk-Treasurer of said Town in the Town Hall of said Town, by all persons interested in or affected by the acquisition of the properties to be acquired and the construction and operation of such project.

The total estimated cost is in the amount of Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000), and the plan of financing contemplates the issuance of revenue bonds of the town in such amount as may be necessary, which bonds will be payable solely from the revenues of said facilities and, to the extent required, from unobligated net revenues derived from other parking facilities, parking meters or parking mechanisms.

The Board of Trustees of said Town will, at 7:30 O'Clock P. M. (EST) on the 28th day of November, 1966, in the Town Hall of said Town hear all persons interested in or affected by such proceedings and consider any remonstrances or objections filed and will finally determine the public utility and benefit

thereof to said Town and its citizens.

All persons affected in any manner by such proceedings shall be deemed and be held to be notified of the pendency of such proceedings and of subsequent acts, hearings, adjournments and orders of said Board of Trustees, by publication of this notice as provided by law.
