

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN
TERRITORY TO THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA.

Be it resolved by the Board of Town Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, that proper steps be taken to annex to said Town the following territory contiguous thereto, to wit: Part of the southwest quarter of section thirty - one (31) in township three (3) south and range four (4) east bounded as follows: Beginning on the south line of Beech Street and in the center of a continuation of Market Street, in the Town of Corydon, Indiana, running thence south with the continuation of the center of Market Street, thirteen hundred thirteen feet (1313) to a point, thence west forty - one and one fourth feet (41 1/4) thence north, parallel with the east line of this tract above described, thirteen hundred thirteen feet (1313) to the south line of Beech Street, thence east forty - one and one fourth feet (41 1/4) to the place of beginning, and that the members of this Board of Trustees for and on behalf of said Town execute a proper verified petition to the Board of Commissioners of Harrison County, Indiana, for the annexation of such territory and cause the same to be filed and proper legal notice thereof to be given.

Be it further resolved that Thos. S. Jones, Attorney for said Town be authorized and directed to appear for said Town, as its Attorney, before said Board of Commissioners and represent it in any and all proceedings there had in the matter of such annexation.

Passed, adopted and approved by the Board of Town Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, at a meeting of said Board of Town Trustees held on the 15th, day of March, 1915.
