DISCRETIONARY ORDER NO. W-4, REVISED JULY 1976

PHEASANT

WHEREAS, it has been determined after thorough investigation that a limited season for the taking of pheasant is feasible; and

WHEREAS, said determination has been based on data relative to the welfare of pheasant, its relationship to other animals and the welfare of the people;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Joseph D. Cloud, Director of the Department of Natural Resources, acting pursuant to the authority of the Acts of 1969, Chapter 70, as found in the Indiana Code 1971, 14-2-3-3; and having given notice and held a public hearing as required by the Acts of 1945, Chapter 120, as found in the Indiana Code 1971, 4-22-2, hereby make the following order to be known as Discretionary Order No. W-4.

1. The open season for hunting, taking and possessing pheasant, except as otherwise provided by law, shall start at 9 A.M. Eastern Standard Time on the opening day and shall extend from the first Friday of November through 30 November.
2. The open season for hunting, taking and possessing pheasants within the boundaries of Atterbury, Crosley, Glendale, Jasper-Pulaski, Kingsbury, LaSalle, Pigeon River, Tri-County, Willow Slough and Winamac Fish and Wildlife Areas shall extend from the first Friday of November through 15 January.
3. No person or persons shall take more than two (2) cock pheasants in any one day nor possess, ship, carry or transport more than four (4) cock pheasants after the second (2nd) day of lawful hunting from the first Friday of November through 30 November on private land.
4. No person or persons shall take more than two (2) pheasants of either sex per day from the Monday prior to Thanksgiving through 14 December on Crosley, Glendale, Tri-County, Willow Slough, and Winamac Fish and Wildlife Areas and that portion of the Pigeon River Fish and Wildlife Area located west of State Road 3.
5. No person or persons shall take more than two (2) cock pheasants per day from the first Friday of November through the Sunday prior to Thanksgiving and from 15 December through 15 January on Crosley, Glendale, Tri-County, Willow Slough and Winamac Fish and Wildlife Areas and that portion of the Pigeon River Fish & Wildlife Area located west of State Road 3.
6. No person or persons shall take more than two (2) cock pheasants in any one day nor possess, ship, carry or transport more than four (4) cock pheasants after the second (2) day of lawful hunting from the first Friday of November through 15 January within the boundaries of Atterbury, Jasper-Pulaski, Kingsbury and LaSalle Fish & Wildlife Areas and that portion of the Pigeon River Fish & Wildlife Area located east of State Road 3.

7. No person or persons shall take or possess any hen pheasant, except as otherwise provided by law.
8. The head and head plumage of each pheasant must remain attached to the carcass while the carcass is in transit to the licensee's residence or placed in custody of another person for processing.
9. No person or persons shall take any pheasants in the following counties: Decatur north of State Road 46, Fayette, Greene west of State Road 157, Hancock, Henry, Knox, Rush, Shelby, Sullivan, and Vigo.
10. No person or persons shall take pheasant from or by means of a motor-driven conveyance.

THIS ORDER SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FIFTEEN (15) DAYS AFTER RECEIPT BY COUNTY CLERK AND SHALL REMAIN IN FORCE AND EFFECT UNTIL RESCINDED OR MODIFIED ACCORDING TO LAW.
