### Steps to obtain a permit for renovation of a “contributing” structure within the Historic District.

- 1. Confirmation of the historical designation for the property.**
- 2. Construction State Design Release, State Form 41191, should be obtained if applicable.**
- 3. Obtain a Construction in a Floodway permit from the DNR if applicable.**
- 4. Apply for a Certificate of Appropriateness (COA) from the Town of Corydon Historic Preservation Commission to insure the proposed renovations will not exclude the structure from its “contributing status”. A COA must also be obtained in the event you plan to partially or totally demolish an existing historic structure.**
- 5. If structure is located within the floodplain apply for a variance from the Board of Zoning Appeals to renovate the structure.**
- 6. Upon approval of the variance request from the Board of Zoning Appeals apply for a permit from the Corydon Planning and Zoning office.**
- 7. Apply for a permit from the Harrison County Plan Commission.**
- 8. Adhere to all inspection requirements required by the County.**
